## PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

1. Library offers a community meeting room and a board room (see [meeting room policy](#)). The board room is available only during regular library hours since it does not have an independent entrance /exit. Groups using the board room must have an adult in attendance.
2. Public access computers are available during regular library hours up until 15 minutes before closing in order to provide for file maintenance time. (see [Internet policy](#))
3. Bulletin board (see [posters and announcements policy](#))
4. A display case and a wall mount display area are available for rotating collections on a monthly basis. (see [display and exhibits policy](#))
5. Certain types of equipment are available for in-house use. (see [equipment use policy](#))
6. Programming for children and young adults includes summer reading program, story times, special programs and activities.
7. Programming for adults includes book discussion, informational programs, and other miscellaneous events.
8. Library programming for children and young adults may also occur off-site--for example, nursing home story times, Headstart, day care centers, etc. Transportation for the children will be the responsibility of the parents.
